

The interim test

The interim test, also known as the **TTT**, is meant as a preparation for your final exam.

The TTT will be conducted by an examiner from the CBS. Your instructor will join you during this exam, in order to get an impression of your driving skills with a stranger sitting next to you.

At the end of your TTT exam, there will be a short discussion regarding your driving skills. During this discussion, you will be told in what areas you can improve on in your driving skills and what you will further have to improve on to reach the required exam level.

A handy advantage of this TTT, is that, if you perform the special manoeuvres to a high enough standard, you are then exempt from having to repeat them during the official exam.

Our experience shows that candidates who have taken the TTT, are almost 46% more likely to pass their final exam on the first attempt.

It is not however mandatory to complete the TTT, but we would strongly advise you to do so. All the students who have done the TTT exam at the CBR, were ultimately very positive and wouldn't hesitate to recommend it to future students.
